

JUDGING PROTOCOL AND FLOWCHART

CATEGORY A:

1. Years 5,6 & 7 Essay Competition (200-400 words)
2. Years 5,6 & 7 Video Competition (1 minute)

CATEGORY B:

3. Years 8,9 & 10 Essay Competition (200-400 words)
4. Years 8,9 & 10 Video Competition (1 minute)

Judging will be done independently by each appointed volunteer judge in the privacy of their own home.

- Judges will give each entry a score of between 1 & 5, with 5 being the highest score possible.

Judges will give consideration to age disparity within each category influencing such things as literacy, vocabulary and technical skill.

This discretion will be entirely up to the individual judge, with originality and clarity of message deemed of greater importance than English or technical proficiency as per the following flowchart.

- The Rotary Mathematician will then collate and tabulate the scores to determine the winner and runner up.

A panel of up to 4 judges per category will be appointed from varied age-groups (generations) and professions, with each judging panel consisting of at least 1 Rotary Club Bacchus Marsh member.

Each judge will assess both essays and videos in their category.

(In the event that there are insufficient entries to warrant awarding a prize, Rotary will consult with Youth themselves to decide how the money might best be used in the community.)

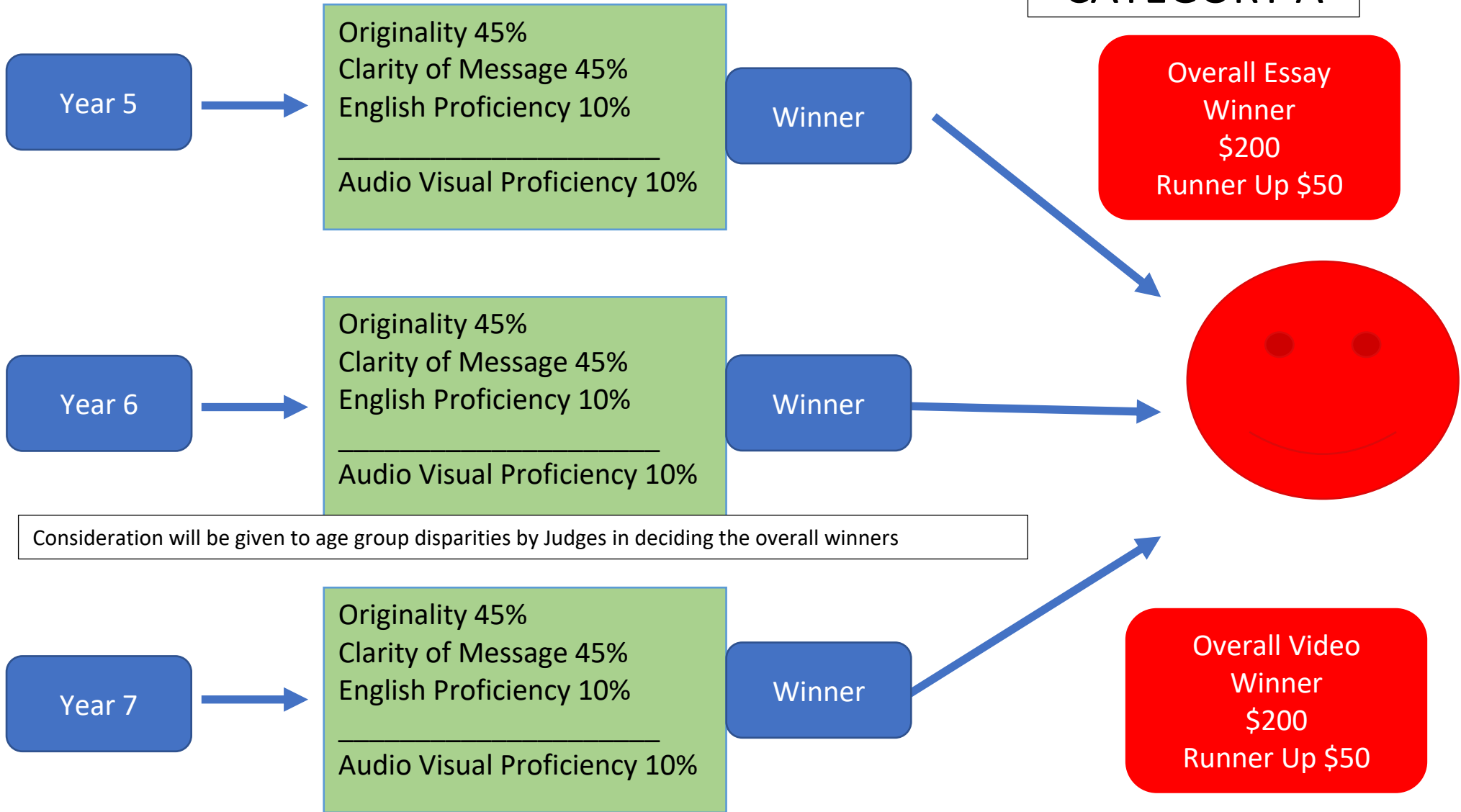
(In the event that there are a large number of entries, more judges will be appointed and entries divided into essay-only or video-only)

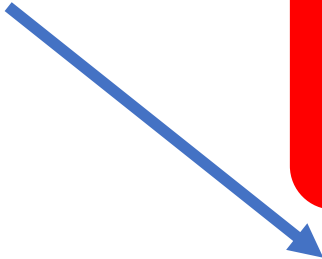

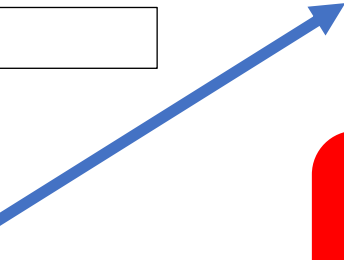
